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# **HOW DO I BECOME AN EVENTING OFFICIAL?**

Thank you for your enquiry regarding the steps involved in becoming an Eventing Official.

The rules that govern the Sport of Eventing are incorporated into the Equestrian Australia (EA) *Eventing Competition Rules* The rulebook may be obtained by the following methods:

### Electronic *(free of charge)*:

### Printed and bound (for purchase from EA National Office):

### To become a Eventing Official you must:

- be at least 18 years of age
- be a current financial EA member with your State Branch and, if residing in NSW, a current financial member of Eventing NSW.
- complete the appropriate application form and forward it to your State Eventing Committe



# WHAT MAKES A GOOD OFFICIAL?

As an official you have to be highly organised, yet flexible. You have to be able to focus, make decisions quickly, calmly and be confident of the training you have received and knowledge you have acquired as an official. You must possess diplomacy, tact and common sense.

You are part of a team and you must be approachable by riders and coaches. You must also act professionally in relation to your officiating.

As an official you must be consistent and fair and have a thorough knowledge of Eventing rules and their application.

It is important for officials to be:

- Physically fit
- Be able to be consistent and fair from the beginning to the end of the competition
- Mentally alert and able to concentrate for long periods of time

The official must have a thorough knowledge of eventing theory as well as practical eventing training.

# REQUIREMENTS FOR PROMOTION

The following information has been copied from the National Eventing Rules. EA members applying for accreditation or promotion as an Eventing Official must direct their application to their Branch Eventing Committee. Please see contact details on the last page of this booklet.

The State Branch Committees are responsible for the verification of all Level 1 to Level 4 officials, Level 3 and 4 Officials also needing verification from the National EA Eventing Committee (EAEC). The Branch Eventing Committee will forward endorsed applications for all official promotions to the Officials Manager in the National Office to falciate presentation to the EAEC for approval.

Financial members of the EA who are 18 years of age and are interested in becoming an Eventing Official, must complete and submit the appropriate application form (pages 9-20) detailing their experience according to the criteria for promotion and maintenance.

Upon satisfactory completion of the requirements of each level, you will be accredited as an Eventing Official and added to the national database.

Accredited official benefits include insurance cover at EA events, EA support, Officials badge, qualified mentors, available ongoing education, name and contact details on web search and news. Each official will also receive a letter, certificate, and badge from Equestrian Australia verifying their accreditation.

In order to remain accredited on the national officials list you must be a current EA member, attend update clinics and compulsory activities or professional development tasks may also be required to maintain accreditation. Further information on this can be found on the EA website and will be sent when accredited as an official.

Contact State Eventing Committee to advise of Interest in becoming TD/CD/J so they can advise on upcoming courses and assist with gaining experience, shadowing, and Mentoring opportunities

Due to competition and course calendar the experience and course attendance can be done in in any order.

Experience gained at events – eg shadowing\*, assisting, officiating and mentoring\* requirements outlined in Annex K of EA Eventing Rules at existing level.

\*EA Shadow/Mentoring form completed at event

Each Upgrade will require new mentor requirements.

Attend EA Officials Course – with notification of intention to upgrade to presenters.

Level 1, 2 & 3 – EA TD/CD Eventing Course Level 4 – FEI Level 2 Course

Recommended that if possible that TD/CD Course Director should not be one of your mentors.

Each Upgrade will require new course attendance.





# Your Declaration

EA, its Branches (as defined in EA's **Constitution**), and its affiliated organisations each have a duty of care that is owed to their respective members, people associated with the Sport, and to the people and organisations that participate in the Sport conducted under the encouragement, promotion, organisation, administration and control of EA and its Branches and affiliated organisations.

In accordance with the procedures set out in the Constitution, EA has adopted various rules, regulations, by-laws and policies (together the **EA Policies**) for the purpose of EA pursuing its objectives stated in the Constitution.

One of the EA Policies is EA's **Child Safeguarding Policy**, which commenced into force on 17 December 2021 and which is adopted by EA as part of EA's **National Integrity Framework**. Any reference in this declaration to the Child Safeguarding Policy is a reference to that document which came into force on 17 December 2023, as amended from time to time thereafter.

In accordance with its duty of care, and as required by its Child Safeguarding Policy, EA must investigate and collect information, in relation to any person who makes application for registration as an **EA Official**. - 2. There are no criminal charges that have been laid against me in any jurisdiction in Australia or elsewhere, which are pending or which are yet to be determined and finalised.

- Be impartial
- Avoid any situation which may lead to a conflict of interest
- Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction
- Value the individual in sport
- Preserve and protect the standing and reputation of the organisation
- Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of the EA Member Protection Policy.

# The FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse

- 1. The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.
- 2. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 3. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 4. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 5. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
