Responsibility: It is the rider, or persons responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event. Conditions are published in the programmeme and this schedule.

Official start time: The official event start time is 8am Wednesday 4th March 2015. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ rule 478.9 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.

Rider Briefing: Wednesday 4th March 2015, 6.00 pm in the stadium. All riders' attendance is strongly recommended.

Event Conditions

- 1. **Rules:** All competitions will be run under ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage and FEI GR's, VR's and Rules for Dressage where applicable.
- 2. **Amendments:** The OC reserves the right to alter the programmeme/schedule and/or prize money within the FEI Rules, ESNZ GR's/Dressage NZ Rules.
- 3. Proof of qualification is the responsibility of the person responsible or competitor.
- 4. **Balloting**: In all levels, the OC reserves the right to ballot horses/ponies in all levels if excessive entries are received. In principle there will be a limit of approx 35 starters per class. Riders should submit the horse/pony best 3 scores and the average of these scores at Regional or National Events in the level entered since 1 January 2014, if balloting is required, priority will be given to the best performed horses on this basis. If this information is not provided for any entrant they will be waitlistes first.
- 5. **Upgradings:** Please notify Sara Bright immediately. Failure to do so prior to show will result in no refund and additional entry fees charged. Other changes at event, a fee of \$15 per class is applicable.
- 6. **Presentation of Prizes and Prize Money**: See DR article 485. Presentation times will be advised in the programme. The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods to the equal value. All prize money will be paid within 21 days of the event, please provide bank account details on entry form. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving. Riders with conflicting classes must nominate another person to the Prize Giving Co-ordinator to collect prizes/rosettes at the prizegiving.
- 7. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30 pm each evening on the results board. The OC reserves the right to alter the programme to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
- 8. Identification Papers: ESNZ Horse/Pony Identification Papers must be available at all times at the event.
- 9. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
- 10. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- 11. Dressage NZ reserves the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications and other promotions as they see fit.

Bates Saddle Draw

Any competitor that has competed in round 2 of the championships and has not won the Bates prize draw in the past two years goes in the draw to win a Bates saddle of their choice up to the recommended retail value of \$4999, donated by Bates Saddles. This prize will be drawn at the Dressage Musical Spectacular Saturday evening March 7th 2015. Riders must be present to collect their prize or it will be redrawn.

Venue Conditions

Horse Identification, Stabling, Accommodation & Wash Down Bays

- 1. Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing. When not competing, all horses should have identification tags or ESNZ numbers attached. It is requested that during non competition times these ID tags also include horse and person responsible name and contact.
- 2. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. Muck bins will be located near each yard/stable.
- 3. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
- 4. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
- 5. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
- 6. Please use the skips provided for horse waste not rubbish, wheelie bins are provided for rubbish only.

General

- 1. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk
- 2. No dogs are permitted at the event
- 3. No smoking in any buildings or in stable areas
- 4. Neither Manfeild Park Stadium, ESNZ, or Dressage NZ nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
- 5. Manfeild Park Stadium, ESNZ, or Dressage NZ shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such goods/equipment, brought in/stored at the venue, during the period of use.
- 6. Damage to Manfeild Park Stadium facilities to be reported to the Manfeild Office or DNZ Event Office.
- 7. Safety hats must be worn at all times when riding at the Manfeild Centre except as in DNZ Art 480 re safety hats and top hats during competition.
- 8. All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives express permission otherwise.

Vehicles & Access

- 1. Access to venue after 7.30pm will be via Kawakawa Rd. All gates will be locked at 10.00pm daily. For access after that time arrangements will need to be made with on site security.
- 2. There is no vehicle access around the stadium area.
- 3. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph. Motorbikes may not be used after 8.30 pm & must be used in accordance with normal road rules. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times. Any competitor contravening these rules will be fined & immediately eliminated from any further participation in theevent. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated. Junior drivers (under 16yrs) must only use motorbikes under parental supervision.

Camping & Power Sites

- 1. Parking and camping areas will be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only.
- 2. Day competitors must only park in designated day parking areas.
- 3. Trucks and Campervans will be allocated specific powered sites and must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords
- 4. Please be tidy and use green wheelie bins for all rubbish no animal waste in green bins.
- 5. Waste Water (Grey water tanks) must only be dumped in the waste water dump in the centre of the oval.

Code of Conduct

- 1. In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
- 2. The well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
- 3. All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
- 4. The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
- 5. Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
- 6. Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
- 7. In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
- 8. All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
- 9. National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
- 10. The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during national and international events, but also in training.
- 11. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.

Entry Notes & Conditions

- 1. Only entries received on official ESNZ entry forms, accompanied by all fully completed additional forms and correct entry fees will be accepted. Incorrect, fax or phone entries will not be accepted.
- 2. All rider entry forms and horse registration stickers submitted with entries must be current to the 7th March 2015 inclusive or will not be accepted.
- 3. Entry fee cheques will not be banked before the closing date of entries.
- 4. Draw will be available by email and web site www.nzequestrian.org.nz.
- 5. Withdrawals and Refunds Please see withdrawal form.

North Island/National Challenge Finals

- 1. No prior qualification, but if excessive entries are received in any level, priority will be given to horses who have gained the following %: Levels 1 –3 63%, Level 4 60%, Levels 5 9 58% in a Challenge class at a Regional or Island Championship event since 1st Sept 2014.
- 2. Run under special conditions as per article 465. Combinations may enter any Challenge Final in any level which they have contested a Challenge Qualifier at a Regional Event since 1st Sept 2014 subject to para 1.
- 3. Challenge Final classes 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12 must be ridden from memory.
- 4. There will be no equal placing in the Challenge Finals. Refer to DNZ Rule 446.2 which will apply.
- 5. Horses/ponies downgraded as schoolmasters are not eligible to enter the final at the National Championships at any level within 12 months of the downgrade being approved.
- 6. Invited foreign competitors may enter Challenge Finals on the condition they can provide proof they have met the qualifying criteria (as per condition 1 above) as a combination in their country of residence.

Elite Equine Young Dressage Horse North Island Championships

- 1. Horses must be ESNZ registered and be 148cm or over.
- 2. For 4, 5, 6 year old horses only based on the official birth date, Southern Hemisphere born horses 1st August Northern Hemisphere born horses 1st January.
- 3. Riders must be an ESNZ full competitive or life member.
- 4. Riders may compete more than one horse in the Championship.
- 5. No prior performance qualification required for Qualification Rounds.
- 6. Proof of age must be supplied with entry or entry will not be accepted.
- 7. ESNZ Identification papers will be accepted but must be completed and signed by a Veterinarian.
- 8. No prize money for qualification rounds One and Two, rosettes 1st to 4th.
- 9. Tests are available at www.nzequestrian.org.nz/dressage
- 10. Top 2 placegetters in each age group qualifier to go through to the championship.
- 11. Sashes and prize money for age group winner, prize money rug and sash for champion.

Round 1: (30% of final score) the first round qualifying test will be

4 yr old: Equestrian Australia State Championships Commanded test for 4 year olds.

5 yr old: Equestrian Australia Young Dressage Horse Commanded test for 5 year olds.

6 yr old: Equestrian Australia Young Dressage Horse Commanded test for 6 year olds.

The test will be ridden two horses at a time in a 60x20m arena.

Round 2: (30% of final score) The FEI 4yr old, & FEI Preliminary 5 & 6yr old Preliminary test will be used except the 6 year old have the option of a simple change or flying change. Test ridden individually.

Round 3: Independent Rider Assessment (40% of the final score) The top two horses in each age group, based on total % in the first two qualifying tests will compete in the Independent Rider phase. The horses will be drawn for order within each age group and presented to the independent rider, commencing with 4 year olds, 5 year olds, then 6 year olds. The independent rider will ride the horses for a maximum of 6 minutes in walk, trot and canter on both reins with lengthening in the trot and canter. The independent rider may ask the 6yr old for a flying change. At the end of 6 minutes, a bell will be rung by the steward. The rider will then give the horses score and make a brief comment on the ridability of each horse. The independent rider score will be added to the score from Rounds 1 & 2.

Elite Equine YDH Champion – is to be selected from the winners of each age group (3 in total) selected after consultation between the chief judges from rounds 1 and 2 and the guest rider. No scores are carried forward. Astek Stud Trophy kindly donated by Sue and Keith Fowler is awarded to the NZ Young Dressage Horse Champion. The Glenvar Trophy kindly donated by Kevin Cholmondeley-Smith is awarded to the breeder of the top placed NZ bred horse at the National Final.

The Flight Centre Amateur Rider Championships Round One

- 1. Qualification One total score 63% at Local, Regional, Island, National Championship or Horse of the Year. Horses with less than 200 grading points in grade entered. Riders C5 and below.
- 2. Classes 1, 2 & 3 are non-graded and run under special conditions and may be commanded
- 3. Prizes No prize money, Sashes 1st to 5th and Champions & Reserve in each level.
- 4. Eligible combinations may only enter one level of Amateur Championship.

- 2. Classes 21, 30, 31, 40, 41, 42 are run under FEI rules. www.fei.org.

- 5. Riders must also submit fully completed FEI entry form which shows details of FEI registration.

- 7. Trot Up for all FEI CDI-Y and CDI*** horses in the stadium 6.30pm Wednesday 4th March 2015.

- 1. FEI Passports are required for CDI*** Classes 21, 30, 31.
- 2. Combinations must achieve 60% in the Class 21 Grand Prix 2009 v 2015 test to compete in the Grand Prix Special class 30 and/or Grand Kur class 31. Any combination not gaining 60% will be automatically transferred to National Grand Prix Musical Freestyle Class 31a.

CDI-Y

- 1. CDI-Y classes 40, 41, 42 all horses require FEI registration.
- 2. CDI/Y Combinations must achieve 60% in the Young Rider Individual Test class 41 to qualify to compete in the Young Rider Freestyle class 42. Any combination not gaining 60% will be automatically transferred to the National Freestyle class 40a. Rosettes only class 40a.

Bates Championship Round 1 Qualifiers: Qualification & Eligibility

1. **Qualification Criteria:** The following scores must be achieved at a Regional, Island or National Championship or Horse of the Year between 1st January 2014 and 15th February 2015

Bates Open Championships: Levels 1 & 2: One total score 65%
Bates Open Championships: Level 3: One total score 63%
Bates Open Championships: Level 4: One total score 60%,
Bates Open Championships: Levels 5 – 9: One total score 58%

A total score is the final combined marks of all judges

- 2. Qualifying classes: Horses may only be entered in qualifiers for one Level of Championship
- 3. **Level 6, 7, 8, 9 Championships:** Points at date of close of entry.

Level 6: PSG Championship/Hobson Trophy, for horses that have gained not more than 60 points in Level 7 at date of close of entry. Ie: Horses that have gained more than 60 points in level 7 or above may not contest the PSG Championship but can contest the Level 7 Advanced Championship for the Surrey Trophy.

Level 8: Inter II Championship for the Trotter Trophy, for horses that have gained not more than 60 points in Level 9 or above at date of close of entry. Ie: Horses that have gained more than 60 points in level 9 may not contest the level 8 (Intermediate A & B) Championship but can contest the Grand Prix Level 9 Championship for the Burkner Medal.

- 4. **Qualification after close of entries.** Riders who intend to qualify at Northern Hawkes Bay, Northland or Taranaki Championships must still enter by the closing date 29 January 2015.
- 5. Proof of qualification is the responsibility of person responsible or competitor.
- 6. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th in all Championship Round 1 classes.
- 7. Both Championship Rounds 1 and 2 must be entered no entries at event.

Bates Championship Round 2 Qualifiers

- 1. To be eligible for Championship points in round two, competitors must have started in Championship round one. Points are allocated 30 for 1st to 1.5 for 20th in all Championship round 2 classes.
- 2. All Championship Round 2 tests on Satuday, Classes 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 must be ridden from memory.
- 3. For Grade Champions & Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the final qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in two qualifiers will be the winner.
- 4. All Grade Champions receive a Bates presentation rug, sash and garland.

Gateshead Equestrian Masters Championships

Winner awarded on highest championship points in Championship level contested. In the event of equal placings the higher grade will win.

Qualification Criteria

- Category 1 4 Masters Riders 55 yrs & over (age at the beginning of the calendar year the rider turns 55)
- Category 5 9 Masters Riders 55 yrs & over (age at the beginning of the calendar year the rider turns 55)

Prizes - No prize money, Champions & Reserve sashes awarded.

Hirepool Helen Holden Memorial Teams Event

- 1. Open to teams from areas affiliated to Equestrian Sports NZ.
- 2. Teams entry must be submitted by 5pm Friday 27th February 2015.To Sara Bright, Bates NZ Dressage Championships, PO Box 143, Paraparaumu.
- 3. Teams must be nominated by area groups and entry form signed by two officials.
